Consignment Policy

Consignments will run for 90 days. The first 30 days, the item will maintain full price. After 30 days, the item will be marked down 25% of the original price. After 60 days, the item will be marked down 50% of the original price. At the end of 90 days, you will be notified that the item has not sold and you will have 7 days to pick up the item. At the end of the 7 days period, the item becomes the property of Opal Ann's Attic and will be donated. It is the responsibility of each consignee to keep track of the consignment dates. (Opal Ann's Attic will not try to contact you after the 7 days.) Opal Ann's Attic reserves the right to set the price of each item consigned.

Opal Ann's Attic maintains the right to automatically give a 10% discount. Consignment payments will be made at the end of the 90-day consignment period only. You can make arrangements to pick up your check. You can also turn your consignment payment in for merchandise credit. You will receive a complete breakdown of any sale of your item with the check.

The fee schedule for any and all consignments is 40% of the final price. Add 4% for electronic transactions. (Debit and Credit Cards)

All items accepted for consignment must be clean and ready for sale upon drop off. Clothing must be clean and pressed, in need of NO repairs (no holes, missing or broken buttons, fading torn or loose linings or stains). Any defect must be disclosed. All clothing items should be on hangers (hangers can be returned). All clothing items should be no more than 2-3 years old unless they fall within the "Vintage" category. Opal Ann's will accept no more than 15 items of clothing per week per consignee. Please call ahead if the items are large. Time allowing, all drop off items will be inspected during regular business hours. Opal Ann's reserves the right to refuse any item without cause.

Furniture and "hard" items for consignment must be clean and ready for sale. Any defects must be disclosed. Any information about the item is always helpful. Opal Ann's reserves the right to refuse any item.

If you are consigning "new" items, any tags should be left on. If you are consigning "used" items, any cleaning tags should be left attached. You will be required to provide the size of each garment. Remember that seasonal clothing will sell much faster. It is hard to sell a Christmas sweater in the summer. Any items that require batteries, batteries must be included or the item will be automatically refused. Any electronic item will be checked to verify that it is in good working order.

There are certain "items" that Opal Ann's Attic will NOT accept EVER:

Curtain Rods
Dead Appliances and Electronics
Used Toilet Seats
Window Shades and Blinds

Drilled Bowling Balls
Perishable Foods or Produce
Live Animals
Leaking Gas Powered Items

Consignee certifies that all items accepted for consignments are the property of the consignee and not stolen, borrowed or illegal.

Opal Ann's Attic will make every effort to market, sell and protect all consignment items. Opal Ann's Attic can not be held responsible for damage, loss or theft.
